End of KS2 Y6 Pupil Progress Scores

A school's progress scores in English reading, English writing and mathematics are calculated as the average of its pupils' subject progress scores. These scores give an indication of whether, as a group, pupils in the school made above or below average progress in a subject compared with pupils with similar starting points in other schools.

- A progress score **of zero** means pupils in this school on average do as well at key stage 2 as other pupils across England who got similar results at the end of key stage 1.
- A progress score **above zero** means pupils made more progress, on average, than pupils across England who got similar results at the end of key stage 1.
- A progress score **below zero** means pupils made less progress, on average, than pupils across England who got similar results at the end of key stage 1.
